School bond election Tuesday!

Approval would continue current levy – no tax increase!

Throughout Idaho, supplemental local school levies have become part of the standard school maintenance and operational funding package, as historic alternate fund sources have dwindled.

On Tuesday, citizens and patrons of the Camas School District vote on the renewal of the previous supplemental level for the next two years. Approval of the levy will not increase property taxes.

As did the previous levies, the separate levies on the ballot Tuesday will raise \$250,000 for the overall school district, and \$50,000 for the continuation of the music program. The polling place for Tuesday's election is the Camas County Library, across the street from the school, and the polls will be open 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.! 🐾
