


## Camas Aviator and Photographer Winston Ellis contributes “America by Air” photo to posh New York magazine!

## Public workshop April 4! On new airport section of the County's Comprehensive Plan!

Idaho law now requires that Idaho counties add a section on airports to their respective Comprehensive Plan documents. The Camas County Planning and Zoning Commission has been working on it, and will hold a public workshop on the airport section its next regular meeting, April 4, 2017 at 7 p.m. in the Camas Senior and Community Center. The Camas P&Z is a citizen advisory board that provides land use regulation recommendations to the elected Board of Commissioners.

The public is invited to attend the P&Z workshop and comment on the proposed new Section XVII, Public Airports being considered for addition to the Comp Plan. ## County signs up for Soldier Road bike path grant!

**O**n Monday, the Camas County Commission agreed to partner with the Idaho Transportation Department to accept a federally-sourced grant of \$475,000 for construction, in 2017-2018, of an added and striped bike lane on the east side of Soldier Road heading north from Fairfield. The grant comes from ITD's Transportation Alternatives Plan (TAP) program.

The grant will fund engineering and new construction of a bike/foot path running from Fairfield to 100 North/Manmade Park area or Baseline Road, depending on the construction bids received.

Camas County will be working with ITD and LHTAC (Local Highway Technical Assistance Council) to solicit bids from qualified consultant engineers and eventually, from construction firms. The engineering and construction work, according to County P&Z Administrator Dwight Butlin, will take place during 2017 and 2018. 🍷

### **THE COMMUNITY IS INVITED TO ATTEND A SEVERE WEATHER TRAINING WORKSHOP IN CAMAS COUNTY**

**When:** 10:00 am Monday, April 10th

**Where:** Camas County Senior Center at 125 Willow Ave. W, in Fairfield, ID

The community is invited to attend a Severe Weather Spotter Training Workshop co-sponsored by Camas County Emergency Management and the National Weather Service (NWS). The training session is slated for Monday, April 10 in the Camas County Senior Center in Fairfield, Idaho at 125 Willow Avenue W in Camas County. The session will begin at 10:00 am and will last about an hour.

**Everyone is invited.** If you are a current weather spotter, firefighter, law enforcement specialist, land management employee, emergency services technician, transportation operator, outdoor recreationalist, or just purely a weather enthusiast, this training workshop is for you.

Training will include definitions and climatology of severe weather, training on cloud and storm recognition, storm hazards and safety tips, and weather reporting procedures.

Across Southwest Idaho, over 100 volunteer weather spotters and cooperative observers provide valuable weather information which is fundamental in helping the NWS protect lives and property. Forecasts are often based on observer data, and even warnings for severe weather have been issued based on information received from trained volunteer spotters, cooperative observers and/or relayed by a HAM operator.


