



## Forest Service to host information open house next Thursday about restoration (!) of the Ketchum/Featherville road in Camas County!

**A**s you may have noticed, FS Road 227 up north in the Fairfield Ranger District has gone missing in a number of spots due to debris flows in 2014 and 2015 in the aftermath of the 2013 Kelly Fire, and in 2017, floods on Big Smoky Creek and the South Fork of the Boise River following the record snow pack in 2016/2017. Remember that???? The years of interruption of general traffic on FS 227 has cruelly impacted backcountry use for Camas residents and other users, shattering the popular dirt-road link between Big Smoky and the Baumgartner Campground area. This has effectively blocked camping, offroad access, emergency access and scenic travel in what has traditionally been primo recreational country in the river reaches below Big Smoky. Sob!!!

**S**o what are you doing a week from Thursday! On that glorious day, the USFS will hold a public meeting at the Senior Center (February 1, at 6 p.m.) at which all will be revealed about its plans (plans compounded in conjunction with its maintenance partner, Camas County) to restore this public land superhighway to its former functional glory! The crucial bits of the plan within Camas County includes some graceful and mature concessions to the Big

Smoky/South Fork's apparent determination to occupy the lowest part of the canyon, which water perversely tends to do.

**T**he Plan, Revealed! So the plan proposes the relocation of the traditional (washed away) roadbed uphill in two quarter-mile segments along the South Fork, around the 2014/15 debris flows east of Deadwood Creek and west of Big Hole. And the other ambitious portion of the plan will relocate FS 227 around the Big Smoky washouts west of Bowns Campground, by taking an adventurous bypass up to Fleck Summit and thence winding south and west across the mountainside back to a giddy reunion with old FS 227 near the confluence! The Fleck Summit work would also include widening of 3.2 miles of road from Big Smoky to north of Fleck to handle the increased traffic on FS 227 to the summit.


## Passage: Naomi Rast Memorial Service Saturday at 2 p.m.!

# Terry Lee strides into Idaho Weed Control Hall of Fame!

## A prominent and accomplished Grim Weeder of Idaho invasive species!

**T**erry Lee, Camas County Weed Supervisor, was named on January 17 to the Idaho Weed Control Hall of Fame during the 2018 Idaho Weed Conference in Boise. The selection was made by the board of the Idaho Weed Control Association.



### A Statewide Legacy!

With 16 years of front-line service as Camas County's Weed Supervisor, Lee has productively planted himself in the fertile soil of Idaho's economically crucial noxious weed control effort. He currently serves in a number of statewide positions:

- Chairman of the Idaho Association of Weed Control Supervisors
- Vice President of the Idaho Weed Control Association
- Representative on the Idaho Weed control Coordinating Committee

### Himself: a Member of a Native Species!

Terry Lee's non-invasive roots run deep in Camas Prairie soil! A Fairfield native and member of the widespread Lee genus of Camas humans, Lee is a

1980 graduate and track athlete at Camas County High School, and to this day, holds the school record for the 1,600 meter and 3,200 meter runs. (That's 1 mile and 2 miles.) He also occasionally plays the harmonica at community musical events!

For Camas County, Lee manages a year-round program of planning and fieldwork of vegetation management on public and private acreage, both terrestrial and aquatic. The department's annual budget tops \$300,000 counting contracts with the BLM, USFS, Idaho agencies, and private owners, with most of the funding going for sophisticated weed control chemicals and biological agents.




### The Mission: Weed Control!

According to the Board of County Commissioners, "the mission of Terry Lee and his crew is critical to the County's services to citizens. Agriculture is the principal lifeline for economic survival of people in Camas County. There are perennial challenges to agricultural production here, in a high desert, high-altitude farming community with limited water and a short growing season. Noxious weeds pose a lethal production challenge, and one that merits the full attention of Terry Lee and his capable crew."

This year's Hall of Fame induction class also included another front-line weed warrior, Kim Ragotzkie of High Country RCD in eastern Idaho, as well as two Boise officials: ISDA director Celia Gould, and Senator Shawn Keogh of Sandpoint. The latter two, the board noted, have been conspicuous toilers in the metaphorically sweaty fields of the Idaho state capitol, digging up funding and support for state-managed weed control measures benefiting Idaho agriculture!
